HOW TO PLANT THAT AWESOME HASKAP BUSH

First, haskaps need a partner to pollinate and produce these scrumptious berries. Our plant pairs are newer varieties and amazing producers: ~~Beauty and Beast~~ (sold out for 2024—hoping we have more for 2025) plus **Aurora** and **Honeybee**. Plants should be planted approx a 1-1.5 metres apart for best cross pollinating.

When you take the bush out of the bag score each side and split any tangled/rootbound roots. Watering is very important the first few years. Well established plants do not need as much water. Plants do best in well drained soil.

Keep grass and weeds away from new bushes. Glyphosate herbicides are **not** recommended. We hand weed all our bushes.

Netting is crucial when you have berries. Though pretty, Cedar Wax Wings will wipe out your berry supply quickly. Raccoons are also fans and will have a party if they find your bushes. We speak from experience and now surround our field with low electric fencing. Luckily Gypsy moths don't seem to care for haskaps thank goodness! ENJOY!!
